	A BILL FOR AN ACT
101	CONCERNING LEASE RATES FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS TOWER
102	GROUND LEASES ON STATE LAND MANAGED BY THE STATE
103	BOARD OF LAND COMMISSIONERS IN RURAL AREAS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. For ground leases for the construction and operation of telecommunications towers on state land managed by the state board of land commissioners (board) in rural areas of the state, the bill requires the board to set a lease rate based on a local market-based appraisal of telecommunications lease rates in the rural area.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 36-1-147.8 as
3	follows:
4	36-1-147.8. Ground leases for construction and operation of
5	telecommunications towers on state land in rural areas - definition.
6	(1) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 36-1-113 OR 36-1-118, WHEN THE STATE
7	BOARD OF LAND COMMISSIONERS IS CONSIDERING A GROUND LEASE FOR
8	THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A TELECOMMUNICATIONS TOWER
9	ON THE LAND OF THE STATE IN RURAL AREAS, THE LEASE RATE MUST BE
10	BASED ON A LOCAL MARKET-BASED APPRAISAL OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS
11	LEASE RATES IN THE RURAL AREA.
12	(2) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "RURAL AREA" MEANS:
13	(a) A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION OF FEWER THAN THIRTY
14	THOUSAND PEOPLE; OR
15	(b) A MUNICIPALITY WITH A POPULATION OF FEWER THAN TWENTY
16	THOUSAND PEOPLE IF THE MUNICIPALITY IS NOT CONTIGUOUS TO A
17	MUNICIPALITY WITH A POPULATION OF TWENTY THOUSAND PEOPLE OR
18	MORE.
19	SECTION 2. Applicability. This act applies to leases entered
20	into on or after the effective date of this act.
21	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
22	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
23	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
