Bill Summary

Sunset Process - House Agriculture, Water, and Natural Resources Committee. The Colorado fire commission (commission) was created in the division of fire prevention and control in the department of

public safety. The commission is set to be repealed, effective September 1, 2024, and is subject to a sunset review prior to its repeal. The bill implements the recommendations in the department of regulatory agencies' 2023 sunset report to continue the commission indefinitely.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1233, repeal 3 (7) as follows: 4 24-33.5-1233. Colorado fire commission - creation - powers 5 and duties - report - legislative declaration. (7) Repeal. This section 6 is repealed, effective September 1, 2024. Before its repeal, this section is 7 scheduled for review in accordance with section 2-3-1203. 8 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal 9 (15)(a)(IX) as follows: 10 2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative 11 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (15) (a) The following statutory 12 authorizations for the designated advisory committees are scheduled for 13 repeal on September 1, 2024: 14 (IX) The Colorado fire commission created in section 15 24-33.5-1233. 16 **SECTION 3.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 17 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 18 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 19 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 20 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 21 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 22 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
