Bill Summary

The bill clarifies that an employee of a retail liquor store or liquor-licensed drugstore who is at least 18 years of age but under 21 years of age may sell alcohol beverages at those establishments if the employee is supervised by another employee who is at least 21 years of age.

(6) (c) An employee of a 6 liquor-licensed drugstore who is under twenty-one years of age shall not 7 deliver or otherwise have any contact with malt, vinous, or spirituous 8 liquors offered for sale on, or sold and removed from, the licensed 9 premises. 10 11 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 12 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 13 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 14 5, 2020, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2020); except that, if a 15 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 16 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 17 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 18 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 19 November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the

official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
