#### **Bill Summary**

**Statutory Revision Committee.** Current law requires the statutory revision committee to report its findings and recommendations to the legislature on or before November 15 of each year. The bill requires the annual report to occur on or before July 1 of each year.





Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-902, amend 3 (1)(e) as follows: **2-3-902.** Duties of committee. (1) The committee shall: 4 5 Report its findings and recommendations on or before (e) 6 November 15 JULY 1 of each year to the legislature and, if it deems advisable, attach to its report copies of any proposed bills intended to 7 8 carry out any of its recommendations. 9 SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, 10 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety. 11
