(9) (a) The following statutory 6 authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on 7 September 1, 2019: 8 (III) The public safety communications subcommittee to the 9 homeland security and all-hazards senior advisory committee created in 10 section 24-33.5-1614 (3.3), C.R.S.; 11 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1614, repeal 12 (3.3)(i) as follows: 13 24-33.5-1614. Homeland security and all-hazards senior advisory committee - composition - duties - emergency planning 14 15 subcommittee - public safety communications subcommittee -16 creation - definitions - repeal. (3.3)(i) This subsection (3.3) is repealed, 17 effective September 1, 2019. Prior to repeal, the subcommittee shall be 18 reviewed pursuant to section 2-3-1203, C.R.S. 19 SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 20 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 21 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 22 2, 2019, if adjournment sine die is on May 3, 2019); except that, if a 23 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 24 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 25 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
