A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY FOR THE PROCEEDS OF THE TRANSFER**
102 **OF A HOSPITAL OWNED BY CERTAIN TYPES OF LOCAL**
103 **GOVERNMENTS TO BE USED FOR A PUBLIC PURPOSE IF THE**
104 **PUBLIC PURPOSE IS APPROVED BY THE VOTERS OF THE LOCAL**

a municipality or county to be used for any public purpose if the municipality or county refers a ballot question to the voters of the municipality or county authorizing the public purpose for which the proceeds will be used, and a majority of the voters voting in the election approve the ballot question.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 6-19-403, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
3 BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

4 **6-19-403. Certification and criteria.** (2) NOTWITHSTANDING
5 ANY OTHER LAW, FOR ANY COVERED TRANSACTION INVOLVING A HOSPITAL
6 OWNED BY A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY, A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY MAY
7 USE THE PROCEEDS OF THE COVERED TRANSACTION FOR ANY PUBLIC
8 PURPOSE, AND PARAGRAPHS (a), (b), (f), AND (i) OF SUBSECTION (1) OF
9 THIS SECTION AND SECTION 6-19-405, DO NOT APPLY SO LONG AS THE
10 MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY REFERS TO THE VOTERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY
11 OR COUNTY FOR THEIR APPROVAL A BALLOT QUESTION AUTHORIZING THE
12 PUBLIC PURPOSE FOR WHICH PROCEEDS OF THE COVERED TRANSACTION
13 WILL BE USED. IF A MAJORITY OF THE VOTERS VOTING IN THE ELECTION
14 APPROVE THE BALLOT QUESTION, THE PROCEEDS MAY BE USED AS
15 APPROVED BY THE VOTERS.

16 **SECTION 2.** 6-19-102, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
17 BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

18 **6-19-102. Definitions.** As used in this article, unless the context
19 otherwise requires:

20 (4) "MUNICIPALITY" HAS THE SAME MEANING AS SET FORTH IN
21 SECTION 31-1-101 (6), C.R.S.

22 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

- 1 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
- 2 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
