Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. On June 1, 2022, the state treasurer is required to transfer \$100 million from the marijuana tax cash fund to the public school capital construction assistance fund (BEST fund).





1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-43.7-104, add
3 (2)(g) as follows:

22-43.7-104. Public school capital construction assistance fund
creation - crediting of money to fund - use of fund - emergency
reserve - creation - reserve account - creation and use. (2) (g) THE
ASSISTANCE FUND INCLUDES ONE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS, WHICH THE
STATE TREASURER IS REQUIRED TO TRANSFER FROM THE MARIJUANA TAX
CASH FUND CREATED IN SECTION 39-28.8-501 (1) ON JUNE 1, 2022,
PURSUANT TO SECTION 39-28.8-501 (4.8).

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 39-28.8-501, add
(4.8) as follows:

39-28.8-501. Marijuana tax cash fund - creation - distribution
- legislative declaration - repeal. (4.8) ON JUNE 1, 2022, THE STATE
TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER ONE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE
FUND TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION ASSISTANCE FUND
CREATED IN SECTION 22-43.7-104.

18 SECTION 3. Appropriation. For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, 19 \$100,000,000 is appropriated to the department of education. This 20 appropriation is from the public school capital construction assistance 21 fund created in section 22-43.7-104 (1), C.R.S. To implement this act, the 22 department may use this appropriation for public school capital 23 construction assistance board cash grants.

24 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
