The amendment strikes sections 32-33 and the associated fiscal impact to the Office of the State Comptroller, University of Connecticut Health Center, and fully insured municipalities.

The amendment results in a potential cost to the Office of Health Strategy (OHS) to the extent they need to contract an outside consultant to meet the provisions of the amendment, as OHS does not have staff with the expertise necessary to conduct the required study.
