AN ACT CONCERNING THE SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS EXEMPTION FROM THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-701 of the general statutes be amended to eliminate
- 2 the limits on taxpayers' federal adjusted gross income for Social
- 3 Security benefits to be exempted from the personal income tax.
