AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF ATLANTIC STANDARD TIME.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1-6 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2019*):
- 3 [The] (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the
- 4 standard of time for the seventy-fifth meridian west of Greenwich shall
- 5 be the standard of time for this state, except that the standard of time
- 6 of this state shall be one hour in advance of such established time from
- 7 two o'clock ante meridian on the second Sunday in March until two
- 8 o'clock ante meridian on the first Sunday in November.
- 9 (b) Upon the enactment of legislation in the states of Massachusetts
- 10 and Rhode Island adopting Atlantic standard time, the Governor of
- 11 this state shall forthwith apply to the United States Secretary of
- 12 Transportation to change the standard of time for this state to Atlantic
- 13 standard time. If such application is approved by the secretary, the
- 14 <u>standard of time for this state shall be Atlantic standard time.</u>

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require the state to adopt Atlantic Standard time upon the enactment of legislation in Massachusetts and Rhode Island adopting said time and federal approval of such change.
