AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY TO DETERMINE A WAY TO DETECT WHEN A DRIVER IS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF MARIJUANA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 2 Emergency Services and Public Protection to conduct a study to
- 3 determine a way to detect if a person's driving is impaired by
- 4 marijuana usage.

Statement of Purpose:

To require a study to determine the best way to detect if a person's driving is impaired by marijuana usage.
