AN ACT ELIMINATING THE QUALIFYING INCOME THRESHOLDS FOR THE SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS DEDUCTION UNDER THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-701 of the general statutes be amended to eliminate
- 2 the qualifying income thresholds for the Social Security benefits
- 3 deduction under the personal income tax.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the qualifying income thresholds for the Social Security benefits deduction under the personal income tax.
