AN ACT CONCERNING SMOKE DETECTORS IN THE SOLID WASTE STREAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) (1) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, on and after October 1, 2027, no person shall distribute, sell or offer for sale any smoke detection and warning equipment that is powered solely by a battery unless such battery is nonreplaceable, nonremovable and capable of powering the equipment for not less than ten years.
 - (2) The provisions of subdivision (1) of this subsection shall not apply to any smoke detection and warning equipment that is powered by the electrical system of a building, fire alarm systems with smoke detection and warning equipment, fire alarm devices that connect to a panel or devices that use a low-power radio frequency wireless communication signal.
- 13 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, a 14 person may sell smoke detection and warning equipment that does not 15 meet the requirements of subsection (a) of this section on or after 16 October 1, 2027, if such person (1) possesses such equipment on October 17 1, 2027, or (2) placed an order for such equipment prior to the effective 18 date of this section.
