AN ACT CONCERNING VEGETATION MANAGEMENT WITHIN UTILITY PROTECTION ZONES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 16-234 of the general statutes be amended to: (1) 2 Include a requirement that notice of any proposed pruning or 3 removing of any tree or shrub within a utility protection zone be 4 provided to the town tree warden and municipal authority charged 5 with oversight of the municipality tree canopy at least two weeks 6 before the proposed work is scheduled to commence, (2) require that 7 the utilities' subcontractor include a check box on door hangers that 8 notifies and gives residents the option of being present when approved 9 tree cutting work is being done within such zone that is located on 10 private property, (3) require that the utility or subcontractor leave a 11 notice at the resident's door with a status update of when approved 12 work on such private property is finished, (4) require the utility or 13 subcontractor to include a customer satisfaction survey on work done 14 that can be torn off and sent to the Public Utilities Regulatory 15 Authority, and (5) amend the process by which notification and 16 consent is given for utility tree trimming on private property as 17 follows: (A) Require notification to the town tree warden and town

- 18 designated tree arborist, if any, of the proposed work to be done, and
- 19 (B) allow the arborist to conduct an evaluation of the work to be done
- 20 if requested by the private property owner.

Statement of Purpose:

To improve the notification requirements and process by which customers are informed and give consent for tree and shrub cutting work in utility protection zone property that is located on private property.
