AN ACT PROHIBITING THE RELEASE OF HELIUM BALLOONS INTO THE ATMOSPHERE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 26-25c of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (Effective October 1, 2019):
- 3 (a) No person, nonprofit organization, firm or corporation,
- 4 including the state and its political subdivisions, shall knowingly
- 5 release, organize the release of or intentionally cause to be released
- 6 into the atmosphere [within a twenty-four-hour period ten or more]
- 7 helium or other lighter-than-air gas balloons in the state.
- 8 (b) Any violation of subsection (a) of this section shall be an 9 infraction.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1 October 1, 2019 26-25c
