## AN ACT CONCERNING THE WATER RESOURCES OF THE UPPER FARMINGTON RIVER VALLEY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) Not later than January 1, 2025, the
- 2 Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection shall submit a
- 3 report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general
- 4 statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
- 5 having cognizance of matters relating to the environment on the need to
- 6 develop courses of action to conserve any land and riparian rights in the
- 7 Upper Farmington River Valley and its watershed area, including
- 8 Colebrook River Lake and any related managed water supply bodies in
- 9 the event that the Department of Public Health approves any
- 10 applications to abandon any waters and watershed areas currently
- 11 protected as a drinking water supply.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
