## AN ACT PROHIBITING INSURANCE COMPANIES FROM USING CREDIT HISTORY AS A FACTOR IN UNDERWRITING HOMEOWNERS INSURANCE POLICIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 38a-689 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit
- 2 insurance companies from using an applicant's or insured's credit
- 3 history as a factor in underwriting homeowners insurance policies.

## Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit insurance companies from using an applicant's or insured's credit history as a factor in underwriting homeowners insurance policies.
