## AN ACT ADDING CHRONIC PAIN AS A DEBILITATING MEDICAL CONDITION FOR THE PALLIATIVE USE OF MARIJUANA BY A QUALIFYING PATIENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to add chronic pain as a
- 2 debilitating medical condition for the palliative use of marijuana by a
- 3 qualifying patient.

## Statement of Purpose:

To allow the palliative use of marijuana for qualifying patients with chronic pain.
