AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF STATE FINANCE POLICIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) The Commissioners of Economic and
- 2 Community Development and Revenue Services shall study the finance
- 3 policies of this state and surrounding states to identify programmatic
- 4 and legislative changes that may be made to develop the economic
- 5 competitiveness of the state. The commissioners may consult with any
- 6 individuals, businesses and state agencies the commissioners deem
- 7 necessary or appropriate to accomplish the purposes of the study. Not
- 8 later than January 1, 2021, the commissioners shall submit a report, in
- 9 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
- 10 on the commissioners' findings and recommendations to the joint
- 11 standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of
- 12 matters relating to commerce and finance, revenue and bonding.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
