AN ACT RESTORING ELECTORAL PRIVILEGES TO CONVICTED FELONS WHO ARE ON PAROLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to restore the
- 2 electoral privileges of any convicted felon who has been released from
- 3 confinement in a correctional institution or facility or a community
- 4 residence but who has not been discharged from parole.

Statement of Purpose:

To restore the electoral privileges of convicted felons who are on parole.
