AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY TO EXPAND ACCESS TO COST-EFFICIENT HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED CARE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a task force be established to study models to expand access to
- 2 cost-efficient home and community-based care, including the
- 3 authorization of Miller Trusts to obtain Medicaid income eligibility
- 4 and fund Medicaid expenses assigned to a Medicaid recipient after
- 5 expenses allowable under federal law.

Statement of Purpose:

To study methods to expand access to cost-efficient home and community-based care, including authorization of Miller Trusts in determining income eligibility for Medicaid.
