AN ACT WITHDRAWING CONNECTICUT FROM THE NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE INTERSTATE COMPACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 9-175a of the general statutes be repealed, withdrawing
- 2 the state from the Agreement Among the States to Elect the President
- 3 of the United States by National Popular Vote.

Statement of Purpose:

To withdraw the state from the National Popular Vote Interstate Compact.
