AN ACT CONCERNING A WORK REQUIREMENT FOR RECIPIENTS OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require able-
- 2 bodied adults without dependent children to work or volunteer for a
- 3 minimum of twenty hours weekly to receive supplemental nutrition
- 4 assistance, state-administered general assistance, Medicaid and other
- 5 state-administered assistance.
