AN ACT RESTORING CAPITAL PUNISHMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 952 of the general statutes be amended to restore the
- 2 crime of capital felony, punishable by death, for any person convicted
- 3 under the provisions of section 53a-54b of the general statutes for a
- 4 murder committed on or after the effective date.
