AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL PARTICIPATION IN THE CIRCUIT BREAKER TAX RELIEF PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 12 of the general statutes be amended to allow a
- 2 municipality to elect not to participate in the tax relief program under
- 3 section 12-170aa of the general statutes following a reduction in
- 4 reimbursement or a lack of funds for grants payable to municipalities
- 5 under said section, provided such municipality provides taxpayers
- 6 participating in the program with a one-year written notice prior to
- 7 completing the opt-out.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for municipal relief by allowing a municipality to elect not to participate in the tax relief program under section 12-170aa of the general statutes following a reduction in reimbursement or a lack of funds for grants payable to municipalities under said section.
