AN ACT CONCERNING HOLDS ON CREDIT AND DEBIT CARDS FOR GASOLINE PURCHASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 42-133ii of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that no gas station or convenience store that accepts credit or debit cards
- 3 for the retail sale of gasoline shall place, or allow a third party to place,
- 4 a hold on any credit or debit card account in an amount larger than the
- 5 actual purchase amount for the gasoline purchased.

To provide that no gas station or convenience store that accepts credit or debit cards for the retail sale of gasoline shall place, or allow a third party to place, a hold on any credit or debit card account in an amount larger than the actual purchase amount for the gasoline purchased.
