AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF BOARD CERTIFICATION OF A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER AS A CONDITION FOR LICENSURE, STAFF PRIVILEGES AND CREDENTIALING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the use of board
- 2 certification and maintenance of board certification of a health care
- 3 provider as a condition for licensure, hospital privileges and insurance
- 4 credentialing.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the use of board certification and maintenance of board certification as a prerequisite for licensure, hospital privileges and insurance credentialing of a health care provider.

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
