AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE PURCHASE OF SERVICE ANIMALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2020*) Each individual health insurance policy providing coverage of the type specified in subdivisions (1), (2), (4), (11) and (12) of section 38a-469 of the general statutes delivered, issued for delivery, renewed, amended or continued in this state shall provide coverage for the purchase of a service animal that the insured's treating health care provider certifies, in writing, is medically necessary. For the purposes of this section, "service animal" has the same meaning as provided in 28 CFR 36.104,

Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2020*) Each group health insurance policy providing coverage of the type specified in subdivisions (1), (2), (4), (11) and (12) of section 38a-469 of the general statutes delivered, issued for delivery, renewed, amended or continued in this state shall provide coverage for the purchase of a service animal that the insured's treating health care provider certifies, in writing, is medically necessary. For the purposes of this section, "service animal" has the
