AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH INSURERS TO ACCEPT PAYMENTS FROM CERTAIN NONPROFIT CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require that each
- 2 insurer, health care center, fraternal benefit society, hospital service
- 3 corporation, medical service corporation or other entity delivering,
- 4 issuing for delivery, renewing, amending or continuing a health
- 5 insurance policy in this state accept payments from each nonprofit
- 6 corporation that is operating in this state and in compliance with the
- 7 federal False Claims Act, 31 USC Sections 3729 to 3733, inclusive.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that each insurer, health care center, fraternal benefit society, hospital service corporation, medical service corporation or other entity delivering, issuing for delivery, renewing, amending or continuing a health insurance policy in this state accept payments from each nonprofit corporation that is operating in this state and in compliance with the federal False Claims Act.

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
