AN ACT REQUIRING A COMPARATIVE STUDY OF CONNECTICUT AND LOWER-COST STATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management be 2 required to conduct a study of the following, that compares 3 Connecticut to states with lower overall costs, and to report the 4 findings of such study to the General Assembly: (1) The percentage of 5 residents who receive an earned income tax credit and the rate of such credit in each state; (2) the number of municipal employees in each 6 7 state who receive federal benefits; (3) the number and total amount of 8 federal contracts awarded to each state; (4) the highway funding 9 mechanisms utilized by each state; (5) violent and nonviolent crime 10 rates in each state; and (6) student performance in each state.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management to conduct a study comparing Connecticut to states with lower overall costs.
