AN ACT CONCERNING ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGES TO ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 9-19j of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):
- 4 (c) (1) (A) The registrars of voters shall designate a location for the 5 completion and processing of election day registration applications on election day, provided (i) the registrars of voters shall have access to 6 the state-wide centralized voter registration system from such location, 8 and (ii) such location shall be certified in writing to the Secretary of the 9 State not later than thirty-one days before election day. The written certification required pursuant to subparagraph (A)(ii) of this 10 11 subdivision shall (I) include the name, street address and relevant contact information associated with such location, (II) list the name 12 13 and address of each election official appointed to serve at such location, if any, and (III) provide a description of the design of such 14 15 location and a plan for effective completion and processing of such

- applications. Upon review of such written certification, the Secretary
 may require the registrars of voters to appoint one or more additional
- 18 <u>election officials or to alter such design or plan.</u>
- 19 (B) The registrars of voters may apply to the Secretary of the State, 20 in a form and manner prescribed by the Secretary, to designate any 21 additional location for the completion and processing of election day 22 registration applications on election day, provided the registrars of 23 voters shall so apply not later than ninety days before election day. 24 Upon approval of any such application by the Secretary, the registrars 25 of voters may so designate any such additional location. The 26 provisions of subparagraph (A) of this subdivision shall apply to any 27 such additional location designated pursuant to this subparagraph.
- 28 (2) The registrars of voters may [appoint one or more election 29 officials to serve at such location and may delegate to such election officials] delegate to each election official appointed pursuant to 30 31 subdivision (1) of this subsection, if any, any of the responsibilities 32 assigned to the registrars of voters. The registrars of voters shall 33 supervise each such election [officials] official and train each such 34 election [officials] official to be an election day registration election 35 [officials] official.
- Sec. 2. Subsection (j) of section 9-19j of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):
 - (j) No person shall solicit in behalf of or in opposition to the candidacy of another or himself or herself or in behalf of or in opposition to any question being submitted at the election, or loiter or peddle or offer any advertising matter, ballot or circular to another person within a radius of seventy-five feet of any outside entrance in use as an entry to [the registrars' of voters designated location] any location designated by the registrars of voters for election day registration balloting or in any corridor, passageway or other approach leading from any such outside entrance to [such registrars' of voters
