AN ACT MODIFYING REQUIRED HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR DETOXIFICATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- That sections 38a-492p and 38a-518p of the general statutes be
 - amended to require health insurance coverage for (1) not more than
- 3 seven days of detoxification per admission, (2) not fewer than four
- 4 admissions for inpatient detoxification per lifetime, (3) not fewer than
- 5 thirty days of residential treatment services during any year, (4) not
- 6 fewer than ninety days of nonhospital residential treatment services
- 7 per lifetime, (5) not fewer than thirty sessions of outpatient or partial
- 8 hospitalization services during any year, (6) not fewer than one
- 9 hundred twenty sessions of outpatient or partial hospitalization
- 10 services per lifetime, (7) family counseling and intervention services,
- 11 and (8) not fewer than thirty additional outpatient or partial
- 12 hospitalization sessions per lifetime, which may be exchanged on a
- 13 two-to-one basis to provide fifteen additional nonhospital residential
- 14 treatment days.
