AN ACT ALLOWING PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS THE ABILITY TO CERTIFY A PATIENT FOR THE PALLIATIVE USE OF MARIJUANA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow a physician assistant
- 2 the ability to certify a qualified patient for the palliative use of
- 3 marijuana.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow physician assistants the ability to certify a patient for the palliative use of marijuana.
