AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE COMMERCIAL AND PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Departments of Economic and Community Development,
- 2 Consumer Protection and Transportation jointly study the potential
- 3 commercial and practical applications and consequences of artificial
- 4 intelligence, including, but not limited to, foreseeable human
- 5 workforce displacement and issue a report with recommendations on
- 6 possible regulatory frameworks related to artificial intelligence to the
- 7 joint standing committees having cognizance of matters relating to
- 8 commerce, consumer protection and labor not later than February 1,
- 9 2020.

Statement of Purpose:

To prepare for the modernization of Connecticut's economy through artificial intelligence.
