AN ACT REQUIRING INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDERS THAT ARE STATE CONTRACTORS TO ADOPT A NET NEUTRALITY POLICY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require Internet service
- 2 providers that are state contractors to adopt a net neutrality policy,
- 3 provided each such policy shall include a certification that the
- 4 contractor:
- 5 (1) Shall not block lawful content, applications, services or
- 6 nonharmful devices, subject to reasonable network management that is
- 7 disclosed to the consumer;
- 8 (2) Shall not impair or degrade lawful Internet traffic on the basis of
- 9 Internet content, application or service or use of a nonharmful device,
- 10 subject to reasonable network management that is disclosed to the
- 11 consumer;
- 12 (3) Shall not engage in paid prioritization, or accept any
- 13 consideration to manage its network in a way that benefits particular

14 content, applications, services or devices; and

- 15 (4) Shall publicly disclose accurate information regarding the 16 network management practices, performance and commercial terms of
- its broadband Internet access services sufficient for consumers to make
- 18 informed choices regarding the use of such services.
