## AN ACT CONCERNING CARRY PERMIT RECIPROCITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 35 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Attorney General to (1) annually publish a list of any state of the
- 3 United States, or any political subdivision thereof, that issues permits
- 4 or certificates to carry a firearm with substantially similar standards
- 5 for age, background investigation and training as required by
- 6 subsection (b) of section 29-28 of the general statutes, and (2) negotiate
- 7 and enter into agreements on behalf of the state of Connecticut with
- 8 the appropriate authorities of any state of the United States, or any
- 9 political subdivision thereof, granting reciprocity to any person with a
- 10 permit or certificate to carry a firearm, provided such state or political
- 11 subdivision has substantially similar standards for age, background
- 12 investigation and training as required by subsection (b) of section 29-
- 13 28 of the general statutes.

## Statement of Purpose:

To secure permit or certificate reciprocity between Connecticut and other states that have substantially similar standards for carrying a firearm.
