## AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF POLYSTYRENE FOAM PRODUCTS WITH FOOD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit (1) the distribution,
- 2 sale or offering for sale of polystyrene foam products to be used with
- 3 food for human consumption, (2) schools from using polystyrene foam
- 4 plates, trays, or food containers or packaging in student meal service,
- 5 and (3) restaurants from using polystyrene foam for both take-out
- 6 products and serving of products.

## Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the use of polystyrene products with food.
