AN ACT PROHIBITING FINDINGS OF NEGLECT IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subdivision (4) of section 46b-120 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to specify that a child shall not be found neglected if such
- 3 child (1) is of sufficient maturity, physical condition and mental ability
- 4 to avoid engaging in conduct that carries a substantial risk of physical
- 5 harm, and (2) engages independently in activities including, but not
- 6 limited to, traveling to and from school, traveling to and from
- 7 commercial or recreational facilities near such child's home, and
- 8 outdoor play.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit children to play and travel more freely.
