**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A COMMISSION ON MILLENNIAL AND  
YOUNG ADULT EARNER RETENTION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a Commission on Millennial and Young Adult Earner
- 2 Retention be established to examine the unique challenges facing
- 3 millennials and young adult earners, including, but not limited to,
- 4 college debt, affordable housing, access to credit, mental health,
- 5 apprenticeships, telecommuting, training and asset-building, and
- 6 evaluate economic incentives the state could provide to address those
- 7 challenges and retain young adult earners.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To establish a commission tasked with examining the challenges facing millennials and young adults and evaluating economic incentives the state could provide to encourage millennials and young adults to remain in the state.
