AN ACT PROMOTING EFFICIENCY IN STATE BENEFIT PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require state agencies that
- 2 provide human services to file interagency reports concerning fraud,
- 3 incarceration or death of state residents receiving state benefits.
