AN ACT CONCERNING PROSECUTORIAL REFORM RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING TRANSPARENCY AND PUBLIC INPUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 51 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Criminal Justice Commission to post meeting notices on their web site
- 3 and in other easily accessible locations, and to hold meetings within
- 4 the Legislative Office Building so that the public and policymakers
- 5 have the opportunity to attend.
