AN ACT CONCERNING PROSECUTORIAL REFORM RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING THE COLLECTION AND EVALUATION OF DATA BY THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 51 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Division of Criminal Justice to collect and compile specific data about
- 3 its work and that such data should not be limited to information
- 4 regarding charging, pretrial, detention, bail, plea deals, diversionary
- 5 programs and sentencing, but shall also include: (1) Screening and
- 6 charging; (2) pretrial release; (3) alternative options; and (4) plea
- 7 bargaining and sentencing and that each such category of data shall be
- 8 identified and compiled by individual court districts.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Division of Criminal Justice to collect and compile specific data about its work.
