AN ACT CONCERNING GUIDELINES AND BEST PRACTICES FOR SCHOOL FOOD SERVICE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2023) (a) For purposes of this
- 2 section, "school food service employee" means an individual employed
- 3 by or pursuant to a contract with a local or regional board of education
- 4 who engages in the preparation or service of meals for student
- 5 consumption in a school.
- 6 (b) Not later than January 1, 2024, the Department of Education
- 7 shall (1) develop guidelines and best practices for school food service
- 8 employees to interact and converse with students in ways that are
- 9 respectful and sensitive and support positive associations with food,
- and (2) post such guidelines and best practices on the Department of
- 11 Education's Internet web site. The Department of Education shall
- 12 update such guidelines and best practices as it deems necessary.
- 13 Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2023*) For the school year commencing
- 14 July 1, 2024, and each school year thereafter, each local and regional
- 15 board of education shall annually provide a copy of the guidelines and
- best practices described in section 1 of this act to each school food
- 17 service employee employed by or pursuant to a contract with such
- 18 board who has regular, direct contact with students.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
