AN ACT CONCERNING REFORM OF PAROLE RELEASE AND REVOCATION PRACTICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 961 of the general statutes be amended to require the 2 Board of Pardons and Paroles to improve data collection and transparency by publishing quarterly statistics on 3 outcomes disaggregated by: (1) Race and gender; (2) length of sanctions for 4 5 criminal versus technical violations; and (3) parole revocation outcomes, and provide that the board shall track, analyze and publish 6 7 data on the cost of parole revocation process, including lost parolee 8 jobs and housing, that the board shall implement evidence-informed 9 strategies to prevent unnecessary incarceration and avoid the 10 criminalization of addiction and mental health conditions, when 11 possible, and that the board shall add to its membership a justice-12 impacted person who has experienced the Board of Pardons and 13 Paroles process.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish an assessment process for the Board of Pardons and Paroles that is measurable.
