AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM EARNINGS NECESSARY TO QUALIFY FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 567 of the general statutes be amended to increase a
- 2 claimant's minimum earnings required to qualify for unemployment
- 3 benefits from six hundred dollars to not less than two thousand dollars
- 4 per year.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the minimum earnings necessary to qualify for unemployment benefits.
