**AN ACT CONCERNING INTIMIDATION ON ACCOUNT OF
OCCUPATION AS A POLICE OFFICER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 53a-181i to 53a-181l, inclusive, of the general statutes,
- 2 concerning the crime of intimidation based on bigotry or bias, be
- 3 amended to make it a violation for a person, with the intent to
- 4 intimidate or harass another person because of the actual or perceived
- 5 occupation of such person as a police officer, to assault, threaten or
- 6 damage the property of such other person.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the penalty for intimidating or harassing a police officer.
