## AN ACT CONCERNING LEGISLATIVE APPROVAL OF CERTAIN STATE CONTRACTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that state agencies
- 2 in the executive branch submit all state contracts with private entities
- 3 that are valued at more than one million dollars to the General
- 4 Assembly for approval or rejection in accordance with the current
- 5 procedures used for state employee collective bargaining contracts and
- 6 arbitration awards under section 5-278 of the general statutes.

## Statement of Purpose:

To allow for legislative rejection of certain state contracts if either house of the General Assembly determines there are insufficient funds for full implementation of the contract.
