## AN ACT REQUIRING NOTICE OF A MUNICIPAL OPTION FOR A PROPERTY TAX ABATEMENT FOR SURVIVING SPOUSES OF CERTAIN FIRST RESPONDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) Not later than September 1, 2023, the 2 Office of Policy and Management shall notify the legislative body of 3 each municipality by mail, and, if applicable, electronic mail, of the 4 municipal option established pursuant to section 12-81x of the general 5 statutes to abate all or a portion of the property taxes due with respect 6 to real property owned and occupied as the principal residence of the 7 surviving spouse of a police officer, firefighter or emergency medical 8 technician who dies while in the performance of such officer's, 9 firefighter's or technician's duties.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To require the Office of Policy and Management to notify municipalities of the option to abate property tax payments owed by the surviving spouses of certain first responders.
