AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR REGIONAL AGRICULTURAL SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION CENTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-65 of the general statutes be amended to increase the
- 2 per student funding to twelve thousand five hundred dollars for
- 3 students enrolled in an agricultural science and technology education
- 4 center; further that section 10-262f of the general statutes be amended
- 5 to exclude students enrolled in an agricultural science and technology
- 6 education center from the resident student count of a town for
- 7 purposes of equalization aid grants; and further that the general
- 8 statutes be amended to transfer in the current state budget, for the
- 9 fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, the sum of \$8,226,757 appropriated to
- 10 the Department of Education, for Education Equalization Grants to the
- 11 Department of Education, for Vocational Agriculture.

Statement of Purpose:

To achieve funding equity of the per student grant for agricultural science and technology education centers and the Technical Education and Career System.
