AN ACT CONCERNING A STATE-WIDE STRATEGY ON READING SUCCESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 10-14u and 10-14y of the general statutes be amended
- 2 to expand participation in the intensive reading instruction program
- 3 and the reading readiness program and to invest in closing
- 4 opportunity gaps through research and best practices on promoting
- 5 research-based multigenerational reading strategies.
